



TEMPORARY LOCAL RULES

Preferred Lies

A. When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it from this relief area:

- Reference Point: Spot of the original ball.
- Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: 15cm from the reference point, but with these limits:
- Limits on Location of Relief Area:
 - Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and
 - Must be in the general area.

Penalty for Playing Ball from a Wrong Place in Breach of Local Rule: General Penalty Under Rule 14.7a.

B. When a player's ball **lies in the bunker**, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it from this relief area:

Reference Point: Spot of the original ball.

Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: One scorecard length from the reference point, but with these limits:

- Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and
- Must be in the bunker.

In proceeding under this Local Rule, the player must choose a spot to place the ball and use the procedures for replacing a ball under Rules 14.2b(2) and 14.2e.

Note: It's recommended to mark the position of the ball before lifting and placing it.

Penalty for breach of Temporary Local Rule: General Penalty (2 strokes)

Abnormal accumulation of leaves: *(Only from October 15th until December 15th, when applied : NO QUALIFYING CONDITIONS)*

Any ground with temporary accumulations of leaves in the general area or in a bunker is treated as ground under repair from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1.

Penalty for Playing Ball from a Wrong Place in Breach of Local Rule: General Penalty Under Rule 14.7a.
